

# PRE TRAVEL VET VISIT

## Questions to Ask Your Vet

### BEFORE VISIT

- Do you have experience helping pets with international travel?
- Can you assist with the government import and export forms required for travel?
- Do you offer international pet passports, and can you help fill them out?
- What is the total cost for this process, including filling out any required paperwork?
- What information should I provide before our appointment to make things easier?

### DAY OF VISIT (PAPERWORK)

- Does my pet need any internal or external parasite treatments for entry into the destination country?
- Does my pet have the correct type of microchip required for entry?
- Are all the vaccines my pet needs for travel up to date?
- Is my pet's international pet passport complete and correctly documented?
- Can I have a copy of your veterinarian identification, as some countries require proof of licensing?

### DAY OF VISIT (PERSONAL)

- Does my pet need any specific medications or preventatives for the country we are traveling to?
- Should I adjust my pet's medication or supplement schedule because of time zones or travel stress?
- Do you recommend any sedatives or calming aids for my pet during the flight or transport?
- What signs of stress, dehydration, or illness should I watch for while traveling?
- Are there any foods, plants, or substances in our destination that are dangerous for my pet based on their health history?
